substantial amount of time by (1) going on police ride-alongs, (2) visiting the Police Academy, (3) observing and participating in many training classes and (4) being briefed by several City officials associated with the Police and Personnel Departments; and

WHEREAS, to permit an intensive examination of those police policies and practices that affect the quality relations between the Police Department and the citizenry, the Task Force divided into three subcommittees dealing with (1) Recruitment, Psychological Screening and Selection, Personnel Assignments, Promotions, In-Service Psychological Assistance; (2) Police Education and Training; and (3) Policies, Procedures, Supervision and Discipline; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force issued a comprehensive report with a series of findings and fifty (50) specific recommendations; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Council and citizens of the City of San Diego do hereby commend the members of the Ad Hoc Task Force on Police Practices for their unselfish commitment of time, talent and exceptional expertise and their persistent and coordinated effort to enrich the quality of police and citizen interaction in San Diego.
