

RESOLUTION NO. 223251

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is in the process of preparing the Barrio Logan/Harbor 101 Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, the draft version of the Plan recommends that vacant land be developed in a manner that is compatible with commercial/industrial use as well as public utilization and enjoyment; and

WHEREAS, the Unified Port District is proposing to create access and to afford an opportunity for recreational use of a portion of the tidelands that is consistent both with the rights of surrounding owners and the economic needs of the tuna fleet; and

WHEREAS, State legislation, AB 47 (Chacon) has been introduced which would grant in trust to The City of San Diego certain tidelands within the Barrio Logan/Harbor 101 community and require their development as a park, recreational facilities or open space area; and

WHEREAS, such action by the State would be an intrusion into local matters which would mandate increased City costs for a development that is without local control and preclude the City from considering other options for the use of the vacant tidelands which account for the mixed uses and different needs within the community; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows: That the Department of Legislative Representation is hereby directed to take all necessary action, for and on
