## CITY OF SAN DIEGO LEGISLATIVE PROPOSAL 79-G

Police Officer Exemption From Non-Resident Tuition Fee

Proposal:

To exempt Police Officer Recruits attending the Police Academy from the non-resident tuition fee.

Present Law:

- 1) Requires any new policeman of a city to successfully complete a course of training approved by the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training before exercising the powers of a peace officer. (Section 832.3 of the Penal Code).
- 2) Requires any person, including Police Officer Recruits, not having a permanent residence in California to pay a \$690.00 non-resident tuition fee to attend the Community College Police Academy. Legal residents of California do not pay tuition.
- 3) Exempts students from the non-resident tuition at Community Colleges if they are, in summary, an apprentice, a school district employee seeking certification, an agricultural worker, a member of the armed services, or a State College or University employee.

## Discussion:

This proposal would eliminate the City's liability for non-resident tuition applicable to Police Officer Recruits attending the Community College Police Academy. Completion of the Academy is a condition of continued employment as a Police Officer with the City, pursuant to state law.

During fiscal year 1979 approximately 290 recruits will have enrolled in four police academies including 20 non-residents. These 20 nonresident recruits represent a \$13,800 cost to the City for their tuition at the Community College.

Fiscal Impact: Approximate cost savings to the City of \$14,000 per year.
