WHEREAS, the subject of deleting said property from the Open Space Retention Priority List to make it clear that the property should be developed for industrial use is scheduled for consideration by the Park and Recreation Board on February 20, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the matter was scheduled for consideration by the Southeast Community Planning Committee on February 13, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is zoned MlB; and
WHEREAS, said property may be developed pursuant to its
zoning regardless of whether or not it is included in the

Open Space Retention Priority List, but Mr. Hom, nevertheless, desires that the property be removed from said list; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That Parcel No. 54806 of the Potter Tract, located between Imperial Avenue and the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railroad tracks at 54th and Pitta Street, which property is presently included within Priority No. 5 on the City's Open Space Retention Priority List, is hereby removed from said priority list.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that FY 1979 Capital Improvement Project 29-270 (Martin Luther King District Neighborhood Park #2 in Park Service District #682) is hereby deleted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the transfer of \$330,000 of Environmental Growth Funds from Capital Improvements Project 29-270 (Martin Luther King Neighborhood Park #2) to Capital Improvements Project 23-786 for the acquisition and development of portions of Valencia Park Elementary School site for park purposes is hereby authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Southeast Community
Planning Committee is hereby requested to consider industrial
development on said site within its upcoming planning review
discussions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby reiterates the fact that the adoption of the Open Space Retention Priority List is merely a planning tool and persons who own
