That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

Floria L. Gordon Carole J. Sutton	Police	\$230	Ms. Gordon is an Intermediate Typist, and Ms. Sutton is a Senior Typist. They suggested that found bicycles not be returned to finders after the 90 day waiting period has ended. The California Civil Code does not require that bicycles be returned to finders. This suggestion is expected to save the City \$4,597 in the first year of operation. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Betty M. Conley	Library	\$220	Ms. Conley is a Junior Typist. She suggested that a stamp be used to record the reasons for non-receipt of overdue notices. Since this information was recorded on the patron's file, it was a time consuming manual procedure. Estimated annual savings are \$4,465. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Domingo Monjarez	General Services	\$200	Mr. Monjarez is an Equipment Service Supervisor in the Equipment Division. He suggested that a fork lift be used to transport engines and parts to be steam cleaned. Not only does this save \$1,779 annually, but it also improves safety for the personnel transporting this equipment.
Michael J. Berneathy Larry L. Heath	Purchasing	\$160	Mr. Berneathy and Mr. Heath are bindery workers in the Print Shop. They developed a form to be used in the collating process. This form makes it much easier to correct the periodic misfeeds of collating equipment. This is expected to save \$3,223 annually. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
