

RESOLUTION No. 223477 (R-79-3176)

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the plans and specifications for the furnishing of all labor, material, tools, equipment, transportation and other expense necessary or incidental for

MODIFICATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND STREET LIGHTING SYSTEMS AT THE INTERSECTION
OF COLLEGE AVENUE AND EL CAJON BOULEVARD, San Diego, California

filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of San Diego, California, on MAY 3 1979, and bearing official Document No. 766226, be, and the same are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council has ascertained the current or prevailing rate of per diem wages paid by private employers in the City for each craft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute the contract, and does hereby declare that the wage scale included in said specifications is the said current or prevailing rate for the various crafts therein mentioned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Purchasing Agent of the City of San Diego be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to publish in accordance with law, notice to contractors calling for bids for the work hereinabove described, in accordance with the plans and specifications hereinabove referred to.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible and reliable bidder for

MODIFICATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND STREET LIGHTING SYSTEMS AT THE
INTERSECTION OF COLLEGE AVENUE AND EL CAJON BOULEVARD.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$24,800.00 from CIP 58-007, Capital Outlay Fund 245, to CIP 62-115, Capital Outlay Fund 245.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure, not to exceed \$81,800.00 from Gas Tax Fund 220 and Capital Outlay Fund 245 of the City of San Diego is hereby authorized, solely and exclusively for providing funds for said project and related costs, and authorizing the Auditor and Comptroller, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
