

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 858 entitled, "Local Employer-Employee Relations Act," currently under consideration by the Legislature of the State of California, would govern local government labor relations by repealing the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act; and

WHEREAS, such legislation would abolish the power of municipal governments to establish their own employer-employee relations policies by placing such power in an appointed board; and

WHEREAS, eleven years of judicial interpretations of the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act defining the rights and obligations of both management and labor would largely be rendered useless; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 858 provides for mandatory mediation at the request of either party, by an individual who is not responsible to local taxpayers; and


WHEREAS, such legislation makes permissible "agency shop" arrangements which require each employee to pay a fee to their bargaining organization as a condition of employment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Department of Legislative Representation is hereby directed to take all necessary action, for and on behalf of The City of San Diego, to declare the City's opposition to

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Senate Bill 858, introduced by Senator Smith, or any similar legislation, which would allow an "agency shop" or "maintenance of membership" agreement with employee organizations.
