JUL 9 RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO OF CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNINHABITED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS "FENTON MATERIALS ANNEXATION."

WHEREAS, an application for the annexation of certain unincorporated, uninhabited territory to The City of San Diego, known and designated as "FENTON MATERIALS ANNEXATION," has been filed with the Local Agency Formation Commission, pursuant to Government Code, Section 54791; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer of this Commission has filed a report relative to said proposed annexation, which report has been reviewed and considered by the Commission, and said Commission has found and determined that:

- The territory proposed to be annexed (hereinafter referred to as the Territory) is as described in Exhibit A attached hereto.
- 2. The description of the boundaries of the Territory is not definite and certain, but may be made so if modified to conform to Exhibit B attached hereto.
- The description of the boundaries of the Territory does conform to lines of assessment and ownership.
- All owners of land within the Territory have consented in writing to the proposed annexation.
  - 5. The Territory includes 18.88 acres and is uninhabited.
- 6. The Territory proposed to be annexed is hereby designated the "Fenton Materials Annexation."
