A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE A PORTION OF FAMOSA BOULEVARD BETWEEN WHITTIER STREET AND NIMITZ BOULEVARD, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941 AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

Dail Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.
