		edges of heavy duty equipment be done on the night shift. This change gets needed equipment back into service and reduces down time. Savings exceed \$21,150 annually.						
Ralph V	W. Taylor	Police	\$ 750	One year ago Mr. Taylor earned a partial award of \$250 for his suggestion to copy arrested per-				
		sons' rap sheets and send them to the unit handling the arrest. This drastically reduced the time needed to obtain prior records. The first year's savings of this idea exceeded \$45,905. This is the remainder of his award.						
Ben D.	. Romero, Jr.	Water Utilities	\$ 410	Mr. Romero is a Senior Utility Supervisor in the Systems Division. He suggested that anti-rotating				
•		devices be installed on sewer pumps at Pump Station 77. These devices reduce pump damage. This is expected to save the City \$8,252 annually. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.						
Donald	W. Pyke	Water Utilities	\$ 350	Mr. Pyke is an Administrative Analyst in the Administration and Services Division. He suggested				
; 		that the Quarterly Management Report periods be converted to coincide with City Auditor reporting periods. This is expected to save \$7048 annually in the time it takes to adjust data to conform with monthly periods. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
