

RESOLUTION NO. 224076Adopted on JUL 24 1979

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Eustis Nikas	General Services	\$ 95	Mr. Nikas is a Sanitation Supervisor in the Solid Waste Division. He suggested that only the swinging doors be replaced on Hanson litter can lids rather than buying the complete assembly. Savings are expected to be \$1,855 annually. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
John C. Kersell	General Services	\$ 75	Mr. Kersell is an Equipment Mechanic in the Equipment Division. He developed a tool for the removal and installation of mobile sweeper conveyor chains. The use of this tool saves \$768 annually.
Charles R. Sims	Water Utilities	\$ 55	Mr. Sims is a Plant Operator in the Quality Division. He suggested that the City make its own chemical buffers for chlorine testing. This saves \$540 annually in the cost of purchasing buffers.
Danny A. Lewis	Engineering and Development	\$40	Mr. Lewis is an Intermediate Typist. One year ago he earned a \$50 award for his suggestion to have contractors make enough routing copies of their Affirmative Action reports. One year's experience has shown an additional savings of \$404. This is the remainder of his award.
Bernard J. Spangler	Water Utilities	\$ 35	Mr. Spangler is a Senior Utility Supervisor in the Systems Division. He suggested a modification to clamp used to lock lead into main bell joints. This prevents loosening of seals. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Mortimer F. Christo	Water Utilities	\$ 30	Mr. Christo is a Plant Operator II in the Quality Division. He suggested that overflow discharge lines be extended to reduce the splashing of raw sewage, thus reducing odor. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
