

RESOLUTION NO. 224136Adopted on JUL 31 1979

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
J. Anthony Dickens	General Services	\$ 25	Mr. Dickens is an Equipment Repair Supervisor in the Equipment Division. He suggested that all equipment with small gas engines be repaired at one location. This reduces repair costs and is considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Donna M. Puraty	Water Utilities	\$ 20	Ms. Puraty was an Intermediate Typist in the Administration and Services Division at the time of her suggestion. She suggested that the payroll functions for the Utilities Department be centralized at one location. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Howard W. Wygle	General Services	\$ 20	Mr. Wygle is an Equipment Mechanic in the Equipment Division. He suggested that an adapted transmission jack be used to lift the springs of rear tandem axle trucks for servicing. Although this device was in use at other locations, it was put in use at another location as a result of this suggestion. This was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Marshall N. Morgan	Water Utilities	\$ 20	Mr. Morgan is an Intermediate Typist in the Systems Division. He designed a form to be used by service crews for tracking information on blocked sewer laterals. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Charles R. Lyons	Water Utilities	\$ 15	Mr. Lyons is an Equipment Technician II in the Quality Division. He suggested that a reflective warning sign be attached to a cathodic protection rectifier on the Bonita pipeline. This was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Susan D. Lowe	Fire	\$ 15	Ms. Lowe is a Dispatch Clerk. She suggested that glass console tops be replaced with plexiglas. This provides a small savings, but it was also considered to be a significant safety improvement.
