

RESOLUTION NO. 224188Adopted on AUG 7 1979

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller are hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Margaret A. Watson	Personnel	\$ 75	Ms. Watson is a Personnel Assistant. She suggested that the procedure of notifying each City employee that is certified of the salary to be earned if promoted be eliminated. By notifying only selected candidates, an estimated \$732 is saved annually in processing costs.
Dean Klampe Louise J. Blea	City Clerk	\$ 70	Mr. Klampe is an Associate Administrative Analyst, and Ms. Blea is an Intermediate Typist. They suggested that subdividers be required to submit map recording fees at the time maps are submitted to Engineering and Development for processing. This is expected to save \$1,290 annually in processing costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
George R. Ikeda	General Services	\$ 60	Mr. Ikeda is a Carpenter in the Buildings Division. He developed a more economical method of building sign-out boards using acceptable materials. Savings are expected to be \$604 annually.
J. Anthony Dickens	General Services	\$ 50	Mr. Dickens is an Equipment Repair Supervisor in the Equipment Division. He suggested that front mounted air compressors on refuse vehicles be exchanged by a rear mounted, gear driven air compressor. This eliminates heating problems and was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Joe T. Lemon	Utilities	\$ 50	Mr. Lemon is a Utility Supervisor in the Quality Division. He suggested that emergency exits be added to the underdrain systems at the Miramar and Alvarado Filtration Plants. This was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Mark J. Tiedeman	Utilities	\$ 30	Mr. Tiedeman is a Plant Operator II in the Quality Division. He suggested that filters be backwashed during periods of intense air entrapment. Although savings are difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
