

RESOLUTION NO. 224189Adopted on AUG 7 1979

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Russel Bye	General Services	\$ 30	Mr. Bye is a Heavy Truck Driver in the Streets Division. He suggested that the air shift on a front wheel drive vehicle be converted to a manual hand shift. Savings were difficult to calculate, but this was felt to be a significant operational improvement.
Rupert A. Perry	Utilities	\$ 25	Mr. Perry was an employee of the Quality Division at the time of his suggestion. Mr. Perry suggested that several security measures be placed into effect for the storage of chlorine. These were considered to be significant safety improvements.
John W. Maples	General Services	\$ 25	Mr. Maples is a Senior Motive Service Technician in the Equipment Division. He suggested that the premium overtime (call back) procedure be revised to be more equitable and less interruptive. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
William L. Matthews	Utilities	\$ 25	Mr. Matthews is a Plant Operator in the Quality Division. He suggested that pressure release openings be installed in bar screen rooms at Pump Stations 1 and 2. This was considered to be a significant safety and operational improvement.
Geraldine R. Bollenbach	Utilities	\$ 25	Ms. Bollenbach is a Senior Clerk in the Administration and Services Division. She suggested that 100' scale water and sewer overlay maps be combined into one book. This saves \$270 annually in responding to citizen inquiries.
Frank Marvaso	Utilities	\$ 25	Mr. Marvaso is a Custodian II in the Quality Division. He suggested that walk-off mats at filtration plants be cleaned bi-weekly rather than weekly. This is expected to save \$273 annually.
