WHEREAS, the City has been actively working on various solutions to solve certain critical traffic and public safety problems in City beach areas; and

WHEREAS, the City has been participating in preparation of certain studies necessary for the City's local coastal program; and

WHEREAS, the adequacy of the circulation of traffic has been identified as an issue for resolution in the issue identification portion of the local coastal program; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has proposed experimental programs whose implementation would facilitate evaluation of long range solutions to the traffic problems on Ocean Boulevard and recently occurring critical public safety problems that are causing hazards to members of the public using the beach and to public and private property; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to implement the following temporary experimental programs on that portion of Ocean Boulevard between Grand Avenue and Diamond Street:

To declare and post appropriate signs and markings making a one way street with southbound flow that portion of Ocean Boulevard from a point 150 feet south of Diamond Street to Garnet Avenue.

- To declare and to post appropriate signs and markings making a one way street with northbound flow that portion of Ocean Boulevard from Grand Avenue to Garnet Avenue.
- 3. To place appropriate temporary fencing or other devices as may be necessary to impede traffic flow from streets other than Grand Avenue, Garnet Avenue and Diamond Street onto the subject portion of Ocean Boulevard.
- The City Manager is hereby directed to request an environmental review of the short and long range effects of this project at the earliest possible time; the Environmental Quality Division of the Planning Department will make an independent review of the potential for significant effects caused by the long range implementation of the associated traffic control experiments and report its results to the City Council.
- 5. In the event that this program is successful in returning stable traffic flows, temporal beach access and/or creates an improvement to the declining occupancy of the lower cost visitor serving lodging located in the proximity of the experiment and if the Environmental Quality Division determines that implementation will not have a significant adverse effect upon the environment the City Manager is hereby authorized to make application for a coastal permit making these measures, or any reasonable variation thereof which may in the Manager's judgment be effective and environmentally sound, part of the transportation plan for the Pacific Beach area. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to the authority vested in local authorities pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101(e) the City Manager is authorized to temporarily close Ocean Boulevard to vehicles and to post signs and warnings indicating the closure of Ocean Boulevard from a point 150 feet south of Diamond Street to Garnet Avenue and from Garnet Avenue south to Grand Avenue from the hours of 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., or such other times as the Manager in his discretion finds are more convenient to the conduct of this experimental program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk be directed to set a public hearing in not less than 60 days from the date of adoption of this resolution for the purpose of evaluating the effectiveness of the previously described experiments and making a determination regarding the appropriateness of permanent improvements and/or street closures on Ocean Boulevard.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to the authority vested in local authorities pursuant to the California Vehicle Code the City Manager is authorized to implement any further traffic flow measures as he deems necessary to remedy any related traffic flow problems on surrounding streets and alleys that may result from implementation of the enumerated actions.
