WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Loren J. DeWoody, Jr.	Utilities	\$ 55	Mr. DeWoody is an Equipment Technician II in the Quality Division. He suggested that marine bearings be added to high pressure pumps to eliminate the whip in the shaft. Estimated first year's savings are \$555.
Joseph J. Scelso, Jr.	Police	\$ 50	Mr. Scelso suggested that the physical testing procedure for recruits be rearranged to eliminate some testing. Substantial savings are expected. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Leo Harris	Utilities	\$ 50	Mr. Harris is an Equipment Operator I in the Systems Division. He suggested that a rock and sludge catcher be used when rodding or flushing sewer mains. This is more effective than the old method, and substantial savings are expected. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
John H. Vaughn	Fire	\$ 35	Mr. Vaughn is a Captain. He suggested that gas powered Hurst rescue tools be converted to an electric motor. This reduces the noise level of the tool and allows it to be used in more situations. Savings are expected to be \$1,050. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Flavian R. Geis	Housing Authority	\$ 35	Mr. Geis is a Housing Assistant II. He suggested that standard envelopes be used to mail rental recertifications. This is expected to save \$341 in the first year in mailing costs.
