

RESOLUTION NO. 250012Adopted on AUG 21 1979

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Wilfred L. Wart Thomas A. Johnson Henry Milam	Utilities	\$1000	Mr. Wart is a Plant Operator, Mr. Johnson is an Equipment Technician II, and Mr. Milam is a Plant Operator in the Quality Division. They suggested that a new section of sludge line be installed to the high energy solids contact reactor. This improves reaction rates in the reactor due to the catalytic effects of the sludge being recirculated to the reactor. Savings are \$18,049 annually in chemical savings.
Vertus E. Reinicke	Utilities	\$ 860	Mr. Reinicke is an Equipment Operator II in the Systems Division. He suggested that jibs and adapting plates be fabricated for use with the hydrocrane. This will reduce the number of incidents in which the Utilities Department will be required to lease a crane with a longer beam. Savings to date are \$8,598.
Eldon D. Smith	Police	\$ 500	Mr. Smith is a Sergeant in the Traffic Bureau. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$500 for his suggestion to increase the compensatory time limit of 45 hours for School Safety Patrol Officers. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$18,390. This is the remainder of his award.
Robert J. Daneri Hank Yarznbowicz Robert Hlavka	General Services	\$ 160	Mr. Daneri is an Equipment Repair Supervisor, Mr. Yarznbowicz is a Fabrication Shop Supervisor, and Mr. Hlavka is a Welder in the Equipment Division. They suggested that thick wall tubing be used for the exhaust manifold outlet pipe. This reduces the replacement frequency of the current tubing and saves \$1,576 annually.
