RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUNDS FOR TWO PROJECTS: (1) LAND ACQUISITION AT THE LAKE MURRAY, COWLES AND FORTUNA MOUNTAIN REGIONAL PARK; AND (2) DEVELOPMENT AT THE PARADISE HILLS/SOUTH BAY TERRACES NEIGHBORHOOD PARK SITE.

WHEREAS, the Congress under Public Law 88-578 has authorized the establishment of a Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant-in-Aid Program, providing matching funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for acquiring lands and developing facilities for public outdoor recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation is responsible for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, said adopted procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications and the availability of local matching funds prior to submission of said applications to the State; and

WHEREAS, Part V of said applications contains assurances that the applicant must comply with; and

WHEREAS, the following proposed projects: (1) land acquisition at the Lake Murray, Cowles and Fortuna Mountain Regional Park; and (2) development at the Paradise Hills/South Bay Terraces Neighborhood Park site, are consistent with the California Outdoor Recreation Resources Plan; and

WHEREAS, the projects must be compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions immediately surrounding the projects; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that said City Council hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application for Land and Water Conservation Fund assistance.
2. Certifies that said agency has matching funds from the following sources - Park Fee Account Capital Outlay - and can finance 100 percent of the projects, half of which will be reimbursed.
3. Certifies that the projects are compatible with the land use of those jurisdictions immediately surrounding the projects.
4. Appoints the City Manager as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, billing statements, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned projects.
