

RESOLUTION NO. R-250240Adopted on SEP 18 1979

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Michael J. Ring	Utilities	\$790	Mr. Ring is a Plant Operator in the Quality Division. He suggested that a valve and a small amount of piping be added to chlorine solution lines to reduce chlorine consumption and the formation of certain methane compounds. This suggestion has saved \$7,912 in six months of operation. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Danny L. Lenz	General Services	\$500	Mr. Lenz was a Painter in the Buildings Division at the time of his suggestion. One year ago he earned a partial award for his suggestion to coat gymnasium floors periodically with finish to reduce the number of major refinishing jobs. One year's experience has shown an annual savings of \$22,030. This is the remainder of his award.
Elton E. Eledge	Park and Recreation	\$500	Mr. Eledge is a Golf Course Manager in the Golf/Lakes Division. He suggested that Buckner sprinkler heads be repaired and reused rather than replaced. This is expected to save \$25,415 annually in the cost of replacement. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Robert S. Zarkos	Police	\$205	Mr. Zarkos was a Police Officer at the time of his suggestion. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$145 for his suggestion to use battery testers to eliminate the disposal of useful batteries. One year's experience has shown an annual savings of \$3,504. This is the remainder of his award.
Richard L. Hoot Charles Riggs	Police	\$180	Mr. Hoot and Mr. Riggs are both Sergeants. They suggested that Victim Notification Cards be eliminated for certain crimes. This is expected to save \$3,667 per year in processing costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
