

RESOLUTION NO. R-250242Adopted on SEP 18 1979

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
David L. Gerber	General Services	\$75	Mr. Gerber is a Refrigeration Mechanic in the Buildings Division. He suggested that vibration switches be installed in air conditioning equipment. This is expected to prevent equipment breakdown. Savings are difficult to calculate, but repair costs per breakdown are \$770.
Michael W. Manos	Park and Recreation	\$50	Mr. Manos was an employee of the Golf/Lakes Division at the time of his suggestion. He suggested that non-skid material be placed at boat wash racks. This was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Catherine L. Meyer	Planning	\$20	Ms. Meyer is an Intermediate Stenographer. She suggested that lists of subdivision and parcel maps not be retyped prior to filing. Although savings were difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Edna Gonzales	Police	\$20	Ms. Gonzales is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested that the number of copies of Productivity Reports be reduced. This is expected to save \$183 annually.
Edna Gonzales	Police	\$20	Ms. Gonzales is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested that the number of copies of Personnel Reports be reduced. This is expected to save \$183 annually.
Lucy H. Galvin	City Council	\$10	Ms. Galvin is an Administrative Intern. One year ago she earned a \$25 award for her suggestion to enlarge the holes punched in documentation for easy filing. This has proven to be an extremely useful idea, and another award was felt to be warranted.
