Carolynn M. Goldrath	Planning	\$10	Ms. Goldrath is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested that the Route Slip file for the Planning Department be revised. Her system keeps all correspondence together on any given subject. Although savings were difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Carolynn M. Goldrath	Planning	\$10	Ms. Goldrath is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested a numbered filing system for building plans subject to hearing before the Zoning Administrator. This reduces the search time for plans when the public wishes to review them. Although savings are difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Carolynn M. Goldrath.	Planning	\$10	Ms. Goldrath is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested a revised filing system for subdivision cards using divider cards for major subdivision titles. This reduces file search time. Although savings are difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Carolynn M. Goldrath	Planning	\$10	Ms. Goldrath is an Intermediate Typist. She developed checklists to track requests for zoning variances, home occupation permits, and conditional use permits. This provides more detailed information on each request. Although savings are difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
