## RESOLUTION NO. R-250533 (R.80-1794)

WHEREAS, EDWARD L. GALE, appealed the decision of the OCT 30 1979
Planning Commission in denying the proposed Tentative Subdivision Map No. 78-282 (Mission Cliff Villas), a planned residential development of Lot 35, Mission Cliff Gardens, Map No. 2268, and a portion of Pueblo Lot 1111 of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego, Miscellaneous Map No. 36. The subject property is located on the west side of Mission Cliff Drive, northerly of Adams Avenue in the R-1-5, R-1-5 (HR) and R-1-40 Zones and within the boundaries of the Uptown Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 1979, the Planning Commission voted 6 to 0 to deny the appeal and the tentative map and uphold the decision of the Subdivision Review Board; and

WHEREAS, on October 9, 1979, pursuant to the provisions of Section 102.0308 of the San Diego Municipal Code, EDWARD L. GALE appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on October 30, 1979, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code, Section 102.0308, to affirm, reverse or modify in whole or in part any determination of the Planning Commission subject to the limitations as are placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Council adopts the findings of the Subdivision Review Board as follows:

- 1. The proposed map is consistent with the General Plan and Uptown Community Plan which designate the property for residential use.
- 2. The design and proposed improvements for the sub-division are not consistent with the General Plan and Uptown Community Plan and R-1-15 HR Zoning/Development Regulations and PRD 149 which was denied by the Planning Commission.
- 3. The site is physically suitable for residential development.
- 4. The site is suitable for the proposed residential density of development.
- 5. The design of the subdivision and the proposed improvements will not cause substantial environmental damage, based upon the findings of the Environmental Report EQD No. 78-08-31 EIR.
- 6. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements will not likely cause serious public health problems; however, the map is not consistent with R-1-15 HR zoning and does not conform with City development regulations and PRD 149 which was denied by the Planning Commission.
- 7. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements are such that they will not conflict with any easements, acquired by the public at large, for access through or use of property within the proposed subdivision.

8. That said findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of EDWARD L. GALE is denied, the decision of the Planning Commission to deny the appeal and uphold the decision of the Subdivision Review Board is sustained, and said tentative map is hereby denied.
