WHEREAS, JOAN R. and KENNEDY GAMMAGE appealed the decision of the Planning Commission in denying Preliminary Parcel Map No. 79-237, which proposed a one-parcel Parcel Map of a portion of Pueblo Lot 1287 of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego, Miscellaneous Map No. 36. The subject property is located on a private way south of Roseland Drive, east of Torrey Pines Road in the Single-family Zone and within the boundaries of the La Jolla Shores Planned District; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 1979, the Planning Commission voted 7 to 0 to deny the Preliminary Parcel Map; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 1979, pursuant to the provisions of Section 102.0308 of the San Diego Municipal Code, JOAN R. and KENNEDY GAMMAGE appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on October 30, 1979, and testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code, Section 102.0308, to affirm, reverse or modify, in whole or in part, any determination of the Planning Commission, subject to the limitations as are placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

All of the following facts exist with respect to Preliminary Parcel Map No. 79-237:

- 1. The proposed map is consistent with the General Plan and La Jolla Shores Community Plan which designate the property for residential use.
- 2. The design and proposed improvements for the subdivision are not consistent with the General Plan and La Jolla Shores Community Plan and SF Zoning/Development Regulations.
- 3. The site is not physically suitable for residential development.
- 4. The site is not suitable for the proposed residential density of development.
- 5. The design of the subdivision and the proposed improvements will not cause substantial environmental damage, based upon the findings of the Environmental Report No. 79-06-33 ND.
- 6. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements will not likely cause serious public health problems; however, the map is not consistent with SF zoning and does not conform with City development regulations.
- 7. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements are such that they will not conflict with any easements, acquired by the public at large, for access through or use of property within the proposed subdivision.

8. That said Findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of JOAN R. and KENNEDY GAMMAGE is denied, the decision of the Planning Commission is upheld, and Preliminary Parcel Map No. 79-237 is hereby denied.
