WHEREAS, GLENN A. RICK received a Bachelor of Science degree in General Engineering from State University of Iowa; and

WHEREAS, Glenn A. Rick is a Registered Professional
Engineer in the State of California, a member of the American
Institute of Planners, and was Vice President of California
Shoreline Association; and

WHEREAS, Glenn A. Rick began working for The City of San Diego in 1927 and was appointed Planning Director in 1928 and held that position until his retirement in 1955, except for one year as Planning Director with the City of Los Angeles in 1941; and

WHEREAS, as Planning Director of The City of San Diego, he had the responsibility for creation, design, promotion and engineering supervision of Mission Bay Park from before World War II until Engineering responsibility was assigned to the City Engineer in 1954; and

WHEREAS, Glenn A. Rick was instrumental in securing transfer of Mission Bay Park from State to City control in 1954, creating the first plans for Mission Bay Park, and assisting in the passage of the initial bond issue; and

WHEREAS, Glenn A. Rick supervised the design and construction of the initial phases of the park and secured Corps of Engineers' support for construction of federal flood control facilities that made the park possible; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the W. Mission Bay Drive bridge crossing Bay Channel in Mission Bay between Islandia Hotel and Bahia Point is hereby designated as GLENN A. RICK BRIDGE.
