RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, IN THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND IN THE SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT ON NOVEMBER 6, 1979.

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held in the City of San Diego, the San Diego Unified School District, and the San Diego Community College District on Tuesday, November 6, 1979, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 15034 (New Series) for the purpose of electing candidates; and

WHEREAS, a special municipal election was held in the City of San Diego on the same date pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 15002 (New Series) adopted August 13, 1979, which special municipal election was consolidated with the general municipal election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego four propositions to amend the Charter of The City of San Diego as follows:

Shall the Charter of The City of San Diego be amended to conform residency provisions for City elective officers to constitutional requirements and substitute the words "Council member" for "Councilman"?

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of San Diego County canvassing the returns of the general municipal election and the special municipal election,

as certified to the City Clerk, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of these elections has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines, pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

The whole number of votes cast in the San Diego Unified School District was 139,059.

III

The whole number of votes cast in the San Diego Community College District was 139,059.
