

RESOLUTION NO. R-250809

Adopted on DEC 11 1979

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Charlene J. Calugar	Personnel	\$ 20	Ms. Calugar was an Intermediate Typist at the time of her suggestion. She suggested that job applicants be required to pay postage for job opening notifications. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Ellen O. Duff	Property	\$ 20	Ms. Duff is a Senior Clerk. She suggested that the routing procedure for chronological files be revised. This resulted in a 41% decrease in the time taken to route the file. Although savings were difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Elsie W. Goodman	Fire	\$ 20	Ms. Goodman is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested a revision to the internal mail sorting procedure in the Fire Department. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Manuel Battaglia	Water Utilities	\$ 20	Mr. Battaglia is a Utility Worker I in the Services Division. He suggested that Form UA-770 be revised for use with window envelopes. This is expected to save \$201 annually in preparation costs.
Daniel F. Struiksma	Fire	\$ 15	Mr. Struiksma is an Engineer. He suggested that out-of-service fire hydrants be identified using placards. Although this was done for many years, the procedure was discontinued at one point. This suggestion aided in the reinstatement of the procedure and was considered to be a significant public safety improvement.
Terrance L. O'Rourke	Fire	\$ 10	Mr. O'Rourke is a Captain. One year ago he earned a \$10 award for his suggestion to install berm at Fire Station 10. This significantly reduced lawn and irrigation system damage. This is the remainder of his award.
