Gentlemen:

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, I herewith submit findings in support of approval of subject project. The findings are in response to the suggested mitigation measures outlined in subject EIR:

#### 1. GEOLOGICAL CONSTRAINTS

Christiana has in the past and always will in the future consult with a competent soils and engineers and engineering geologist. All grading operations will be performed in accordance with the recommendations presented in the soil and geology report.

# 2. WATER AVAILABILITY

All future developments will be phased as presented in the Tierrasanta Norte Master Plan and proceed in an orderly proficient manner as requested in the future growth management strategy.

### 3. WATER CONSUMATION

- A. Wherever possible, any area disturbed by grading operations will be revegetated with native or drought-resistant materials.
- B. Low flow shower heads and faucets will be installed throughout the project.
- C. Wherever necessary, pressure reducing valves will be installed.
- D. All irrigation systems will have automatic controls including soil moisture override.

### 4. BIOLOGICAL RESOURCES

Approximately 24% of the Tierrasanta Norte area will be retained as open space. Wherever possible, it will remain as natural open space or will be restored to its natural state and landscaped with native vegetation.

## 5. TOPOGRAPHIC ALTERATION/VISUAL QUALITY

Wherever possible, artificial slopes will be rounded and shaped to appear more natural. The slopes along the southerly line will be naturalized to blend with the existing city owned open space corridor.

#### 6. TRAFFIC/CIRCULATION

Complete traffic mitigation will occur when the proposed I-15 and SR 52 freeways are constructed. The southerly section of I-15 and the Aero Drive Interchange is presently under construction and scheduled to be completed in mid 1980. Also, there are now three left turn lanes and one right turn lane on westbound Tierrasanta Boulevard at I-15.

#### 7. NOISE

All residential structures in areas equal to or greater than the 60 CNEL aircraft noise contour will be insulated to assure a maximum interior noise level not in excess of 45 decibels.

#### 8. SEWAGE DISPOSAL

All future developments will be phased as presented in the Tierrasanta Norte Master Plan and proceed in an orderly proficient manner as requested in the future growth management strategy.

## VII. ENERGY/AIR QUALITY

All homes will be heated by natural gas incorporating automatic gas flue dampers. It is not anticipated that any buildings will be air conditioned. Also, all homes will include time control thermostats.

The San Diego Transit is presently operating an experimental express bus service from Tierrasanta to downtown coinciding with normal working hours.
