WHEREAS, VICTOR T. WIGLESWORTH appealed the decision of DEC111979 the Planning Commission in denying the proposed Tentative Subdivision Map No. 79-97 for Broadway Heights Vista which proposes a four-lot subdivision of a portion of Broadway Heights, Map 3830. The subject property is located on the south side of Federal Boulevard at MacArthur Drive, in the R-1-6 Zone and within the boundaries of the Southeast San Diego Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1979, the Planning Commission voted 4 to 1 to deny the tentative subdivision map and overrule the decision of the Subdivision Board; and

WHEREAS, on November 13, 1979, pursuant to the provisions of Section 102.0308 of the San Diego Municipal Code, VICTOR T. WIGLESWORTH appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on December 11, 1979, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code, Section 102.0308, to affirm, reverse or modify in whole or in part any determination of the Planning Commission subject to the limitations as are placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Council adopts findings of the Planning Commission as follows:

- 1. The proposed map is consistent with the General Plan and Southeast San Diego Community Plan which designate the property for residential use.
- 2. The design and proposed improvements for the subdivision are consistent with the General Plan and Southeast San Diego Community Plan and R-1-6 Zoning/Development Regulations.
- 3. The site is not physically suitable for residential development.
- 4. The site is not suitable for the proposed residential density of development.
- 5. The design of the subdivision and the proposed improvements will not cause substantial environmental damage, based upon the findings of the Environmental Report EQD No. 79-03-12 EIR; however, the problems of flooding on the subject property have not been adequately addressed by the map.
- 6. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements will not likely cause serious public health problems inasmuch as the map is consistent with R-1-6 zoning and conforms with City development regulations.
- 7. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements are such that they will not conflict with any easements, acquired by the public at large, for access through or use of property within the proposed subdivision.

8. That said findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of VICTOR T.
WIGLESWORTH is denied, the decision of the Planning Commission
to deny the appeal and overrule the decision of the Subdivision
Board is upheld, and said tentative map is hereby denied.
