

RESOLUTION No. R- 250867 (R-80-1018)



That a portion of Lot 23, and all of Lot 24, Block 18, Reed and Hubbells Addition, as more particularly described in the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is hereby set aside and dedicated as and for a public street, and the same is hereby named 28TH STREET.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to deliver a certified copy of this resolution, attested by him under seal, to the Property Department for further handling.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF AREA TO BE  
DEDICATED AND NAMED 28TH STREET

Lot 23 and 24, Block 18 Reed and Hubbell's Addition, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to map thereof No. 327 filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, June 30, 1886.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM all that portion of said Lot 23, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the Easterly line of said Lot 23 with the Southerly line of Boston Avenue as said street is located and established on October 19, 1979; thence South  $00^{\circ}03'59''$  West along said Easterly line to the Southeasterly corner of said Lot 23; thence North  $89^{\circ}54'18''$  West along said Southerly line of said Lot 23, 13.84 feet to a point on the arc of a 2,050.00 foot radius curve concave Westerly; thence Northerly, along the arc of said curve through a central angle of  $03^{\circ}18'45''$  a distance of 118.52 feet to a point of reverse curvature with a 20.00 foot radius curve concave Southeasterly, a radial to said point bears South  $85^{\circ}11'24''$  West; thence Northerly, Northeasterly and Easterly along the arc of said 20.00 foot radius curve through a central angle of  $94^{\circ}52'35''$  a distance of 33.12 feet; thence tangent to said curve South  $89^{\circ}56'01''$  East 0.42 feet, returning to the Point of Beginning, all as shown on City Engineer's Drawing No. 13206-A-D on file in the Office of the City Engineer, City of San Diego.
