AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING PARAGRAPH (G) TO RULE 1 OF SECTION 22.0101 RELATING TO HOURS OF MEETINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be amended by adding paragraph (g) to Rule 1 of Section 22.0101 to read as follows:

Rule 1. Hours of Meetings

Paragraphs (a) through ((f) - No change.

(g) In the case of an emergency situation involving matters upon which prompt action is necessary due to the disruption or threatened disruption of public facilities, the City Council may hold a special meeting without complying with the 24-hour notice requirement of this Rule. For purposes of this paragraph, "emergency situation" means any of the following: (1) Work stoppage or other activity which severely impairs public health, safety, or both, as determined by a majority of the members of the Council; (2) Crippling disaster which severely impairs public health, safety, or both, as determined by a majority of the members of the Council. However, each local newspaper of general circulation and radio or television station which has requested notice of special meetings pursuant to this Rule shall be notified by the Mayor,

or designee thereof, one hour prior to the special meeting by telephone and shall exhaust all telephone numbers provided in the most recent request of such newspaper or station for notification of special meetings. In the event that telephone services are not functioning, the notice requirements of this paragraph shall be deemed waived, and the City Council, or designee thereof, shall notify such newspapers, radio stations, or television stations of the fact of the holding of the special meeting, the purpose of the meeting, and any action taken at the meeting as soon after the meeting as possible. The City Council shall not meet in executive session during a meeting called pursuant to this paragraph. All special meeting requirements as prescribed in this Rule shall be applicable to a meeting called pursuant to this paragraph, with the exception of the 24-hour notice requirement. The minutes of a meeting called pursuant to this paragraph, a list of persons who the Mayor, or designee thereof, notified or attempted to notify, a copy of the roll call vote, and any actions taken at such meeting shall be posted for a minimum of ten (10) days in a public place as soon after the meeting as possible.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION
1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING
PARAGRAPH (G) TO RULE 1 OF SECTION 22.0101 RELATING TO
HOURS OF MEETINGS.
This ordinance provides for the calling of a special meeting of the
City Council without complying with the 24-hour notice requirement
in certain defined emergency situations. It requires the Mayor to
notify such local newspapers and radio and television stations prior
to such a special meeting as specified by telephone unless
telephone services are not functioning and in that instance, requires
a specified notice of the meeting be provided as soon after the
meeting as is possible. It also specifies that an executive session
shall not be called during such a meeting and requires a specified
notice to be made in a prescribed manner as soon the meeting as
possible.
