AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12700 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 766809, AS ADOPTED AND AMENDED THEREIN, BY ADDING 1.00 DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY AND 1.00 LITIGATION INVESTIGATOR POSITION TO THE CITY ATTORNEY'S DEPARTMENT (0450); AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO TRANSFER WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND 100 THE SUM OF \$27,178 FROM THE UNALLOCATED RESERVE (605) TO THE CITY ATTORNEY'S DEPARTMENT (0450) FOR ADDITIONAL PERSONAL AND NONPERSONAL EXPENSE.

WHEREAS, the City Attorney's Office was reduced in strength this past fiscal year by one (1) Deputy City Attorney in order to comply with budgetary requests; and

WHEREAS, the department, at that time, was understaffed in accordance with work load standards by one (1) Litigation Investigator; and

WHEREAS, the reduction, at that time, was effected in the Litigation division due to then existing work load priority assignments; and

WHEREAS, it later became necessary to move one deputy
from the Consumer Protection unit to Litigation to accommodate
a very heavy and potentially expensive civil case load; and

WHEREAS, it has since become necessary to return that position to Consumer Protection because of an inordinate growth in consumerism and demand upon the office; and

WHEREAS, that transfer has impacted adversely the capability of the Litigation division, particularly in light of an exceptional growth in litigation against the City; and

WHEREAS, two separate suits and legal situations occurring within the past year have developed to the point where the full time assignment and attention of the Deputy City Attorneys involved is required, thereby making very difficult the application of appropriate effort to other but smaller cases against the City; and

WHEREAS, such assignments further exacerbate the need for an additional Deputy City Attorney and Investigator, albeit not as a direct result thereof: the deputy to undertake the exceptionally high work load being experienced by the department; the investigator to work in the personal injury/false arrest area in support of the new deputy; and

WHEREAS, this request for additional legal assistance will enable the City Attorney's Office to oppose many of the nuisance claims and lawsuits rather than pay small amounts to settle and thereby reduce work load since such practice establishes indefensible precedents; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 12700 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending the fiscal allocations and personnel authorization for the City Attorney's Department (0450) to include the transfer of the sum of \$27,178 from the General Fund 100,

Unallocated Reserve (605) to said City Attorney's Department for personal services and nonpersonal services in accordance with the proposed budget allocation attached hereto as Attachment A.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 12700 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending that portion of the Position and Salary Schedule for the City Attorney's Department (0450) to reflect and authorize the addition of one (1.0) Deputy City Attorney and one (1) Litigation Investigator to Program 0454.

That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and Section 3. he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer within the General Fund 100 the sum of \$27,178 from the Unallocated Reserve (605) to the above-mentioned department and activities for personal services and nonpersonal services in accordance with the proposed budgetary allocation attached hereto as Attachment A.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two (2) public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
