AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IV, ARTICLE 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 44.0300 RELATING TO ANIMALS; AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 5, BY AMENDING SECTION 55.1 RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION; AMENDING CHAPTER IX, ARTICLE 1, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 91.01 AND 91.0706 RELATING TO BUILDING REGULATIONS; AND AMENDING CHAPTER IX, ARTICLE 2, BY AMENDING SECTION 92.0101 RELATING TO THE ELECTRICAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter IV, Article 4, Section 44.0300; Chapter V, Article 5, Section 55.1; Chapter IX, Article 1, Sections 91.01 and 91.0706 and Chapter IX, Article 2, Section 92.0101 of the San Diego Municipal be and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 44.0300 SAN DIEGO COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL
ORDINANCE--ADOPTION BY REFERENCE

The following sections of the County Code of the County of San Diego, California, one copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, are hereby adopted as the Animal Control

to kennel licensing, 16.101 (less all subsections except (m)), 16.102, 16.103, 16.104, 16.105, 16.106, 16.107, 16.108, 16.109, 16.110, 16.111, 16.112, 16.113, 16.114 and 16.115, all relating to animal control and regulation. Each and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of said sections are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Division; provided, however, that any of the provisions of said sections as herein adopted which are in conflict with any of the provisions of this Division shall be superseded by the provisions of this Division.

SEC. 55.1 ADOPTION OF THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE

There is hereby adopted by the Council of The City of San Diego, for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion, that certain code known as the Uniform Fire Code recommended by the California Fire Chiefs' Association, being particularly the 1976 edition thereof and the whole thereof, save and except such portions as are hereinafter deleted, added, amended or revised. Said code, one (1) copy of which has been and is now on file in the office of the City Clerk, is hereby adopted and incorporated as if fully set out at length herein, and from the date on which this ordinance shall take effect, the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the City of San Diego. Wherever reference is made to the Uniform Fire Code in this Article, such

reference shall mean the 1976 Uniform Fire Code.

SEC. 91.01 UNIFORM BUILDING CODE ADOPTED

That certain document, one copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, California, being marked and designated as the "Uniform Building Code, 1976 Edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials," including only Chapters 38, 48, 49 and 57 of the Appendix thereof, but excluding other portions of the Appendix and those portions of the Code set forth in Section 91.02 of this Code, is hereby adopted as the Building Code of The City of San Diego, California, for regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, removal, demolition, conversion, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area and maintenance of all privately owned buildings and/or structures in the City of San Diego, California, providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; providing penalties for violations of such Code, declaring and establishing fire zones. Each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of such "Uniform Building Code, 1976 Edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials," on file in the Office of the City Clerk, are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set forth in this Article; provided, however, that any of the provisions of said Uniform Building Code as herein adopted which are in conflict with any of the

provisions of this Article, shall be superseded by the provisions of this Article.

SEC. 91.0706 STATE HISTORICAL BUILDING CODE ADOPTED

That certain document, one copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, California, being marked and designated as the "State Historical Building Code" is hereby adopted as the Historical Building Code of The City of San Diego, California, for regulating the rehabilitation, preservation, or relocation of qualified historical buildings or structures in the City of San Diego, California. Each and all of the regulations, provisions and terms of such "State Historical Building Code" are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set forth in this Article; provided, however, that any of the provisions of said State Historical Building Code as herein adopted which are in conflict with any of the provisions of this Article, shall be superseded by the provisions of this Article.

SEC. 92.0101 STANDARDS FOR INSTALLATIONS

A. The National Electrical Code, 1978 Edition, published by the National Fire Protection Association, one printed copy of which is filed in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 767666, be, and the same is hereby adopted as part of the Municipal Code of The

City of San Diego, except as hereinafter modified,
amended, repealed, or deleted; and by reference thereto
is made a part hereof as though fully set out herein.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
