AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15268 (NEW SERIES), ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1980-81" BY AMENDING EXHIBIT A THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has adopted Ordinance No. 15268 (New Series) on May 27, 1980; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance established a schedule of compensation for all officers and employees of the City, setting forth therein Tables of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates; and

WHEREAS, upon analysis of comparative salary data from throughout the state provided to Council, it is now deemed appropriate and necessary to amend Exhibit A in respect to Executive Salary Table, Rate 05.0 by truncating said table to adjust and include amounts deemed by Council to be warranted and necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City Auditor and Comptroller has calculated the appropriate compensation data for said adjustment by truncation and has provided said information as required; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 15268 (New Series) entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1980-81"

is hereby amended by amending Exhibit A thereto to amend the table of executive salaries, Rate 05.0 as set forth more specifically in Exhibit 1 attached hereto.

Section 2. The Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to take those steps necessary to amend Exhibit A to Ordinance No. 15268 (New Series) as called for in Section 1 above, by calculating and inserting in said table the new rates attached hereto as Exhibit 1 with the salary ranges indicated.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
