AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND REESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF THE DISTRICTS WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE PURPOSE OF NOMINATING MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 10990 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED FEBRUARY 6, 1973.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The boundary lines of the eight districts of the City of San Diego for the purpose of nominating members of the Council, are hereby established as more particularly shown and delineated on a map showing boundary lines of the districts on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-15370, which is by this reference incorporated in and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. The offices of Council members nominated from odd-numbered councilmanic districts shall be regularly up for election every four years commencing in 1981. The offices of Council members nominated from even-numbered councilmanic districts shall be regularly up for election every four years commencing in 1983.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 10990 (New Series), adopted February 6, 1973, is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
