AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII, ARTICLE 5, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 75.0113 RELATING TO PROCEDURE UPON APPEAL.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VII, Article 5, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code is hereby amended by amending Section 75.0113 to read as follows:

SEC. 75.0113 PROCEDURE UPON APPEAL

- (a) When an appeal is filed, the City Manager shall cause the appeal to be assigned to a hearing officer, who shall schedule the hearing before him/her.
- (b) Both the permit holder or driver and the City
 Manager shall have the right to appeal the hearing officer's
 decision to the Transportation and Land Use Committee by
 filing notice in writing with the City Clerk within ten (10)
 days of receipt of the hearing officer's written decision.
 The decision of the Council Committee shall be the final
 administrative remedy unless a hearing is set before the
 City Council pursuant to Section 22.0101, Rule 4.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
