RESOLUTION NO. R- 250948 (R.80-1896)

WHEREAS, the CITY ENGINEER, by William Schempers, Jr., appealed the decision of the Planning Commission in approving Preliminary Parcel Map 79-318, which proposes a three-lot division of a portion of Pueblo Lot 1288, Miscellaneous Map No. 36. The subject property is located at the southeast corner of Ardath Road and Hidden Valley Road in the Single-family Zone and within the boundaries of the La Jolla Shores Planned District; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 1979, the Planning Commission voted 6 to 0 to approve the preliminary parcel map, with changes; and

WHEREAS, on November 30, 1979, pursuant to the provisions of Section 102.0308 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the CITY ENGINEER, by William Schempers, Jr., appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on December 18, 1979, and continued to January 7, 1980, and testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code, Section 102.0308, to affirm, reverse or modify, in whole or in part, any determination of the Planning Commission subject to the limitations as are placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

All of the following facts exist with respect to Preliminary Parcel Map 79-318:

- 1. The proposed map is consistent with the General Plan and La Jolla Shores Planned District which designate the property for residential use.
- 2. The design and proposed improvements for the sub-division are consistent with the General Plan and La Jolla Shores Planned District Community Plan and SF Zoning/Development Regulations.
- 3. The site is physically suitable for residential development.
- 4. The site is suitable for the proposed residential density of development.
- 5. The design of the subdivision and the proposed improvements will not cause substantial environmental damage, based upon findings of the Environmental Report EQD No. 79-07-23 N.D.
- 6. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements will not likely cause serious public problems inasmuch as the map is consistent with SF zoning and conforms with City development regulations.
- 7. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements are such that they will not conflict with any easements, acquired by the public at large for access through or use of, property within the proposed subdivision.
- 8. That said findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of the CITY ENGINEER, by William Schempers, Jr., is denied, the decision of the Planning Commission to approve the preliminary parcel map is sustained, and said preliminary parcel map is hereby granted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby directed to attempt to acquire said property.
