WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Diane P. Gould	Purchasing	\$ 20	Ms. Gould is a Senior Typist. She suggested that the method for notifying the Civil Service Commission of employees' changes of address be publicized. This was considered to be a significant improvement.
Thomas B. Wells	General Services	\$ 20	Mr. Wells is a Carpenter in the Buildings Division. He suggested that sideboards on trucks be modified to provide wooden posts for anchoring tarpaulins. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement that will reduce tarpaulin damage.
Phillip J. Love	General Services	\$ 20	Mr. Love was a Carpenter Supervisor in the Buildings Division. He suggested that a fence be installed in the concession area adjacent to the Spanish Village. This eliminates a potential health hazard and was considered to be a significant public service improvement.
Russell I. Skillman	General Services	\$ 20	Mr. Skillman was a Senior Clerk in the Buildings Division at the time of his suggestion. He suggested that traffic control lines be painted on the floor of the COB loading dock. This allows the use of the loading dock by more than one vehicle at a time.
Gail F. Jeromin	Planning	\$ 10	Ms. Jeromin is a Zoning Representative. One year ago she earned a \$10 award for her suggestion to provide a work surface by map racks where the public has room to work with the maps. One year's experience has shown this to be extremely beneficial. This is the remainder of her award.
