

RESOLUTION NO. R- 251276Adopted on FEB 26 1980

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
William Schempers, Jr. George Hilton Lester Peterson	Engineering & Development General Services	\$1000	Mr. Schempers was an Associate Traffic Engineer, and Mr. Hilton and Mr. Peterson were Principal Engineering Aide and Electrical Supervisor respectively. They suggested that traffic signal lamp, traffic signal service, and street lighting service be combined in the same conduit. This greatly reduces installation costs and saves \$41,250 annually.
Alger L. Thompson	Park and Recreation	\$1000	Mr. Thompson is an Equipment Operator I in the Park Division. He suggested that new Jacobson sweepers be modified to allow road towing. This is a more effective method of transporting the equipment. Savings are \$10,600 in equipment savings alone.
Louis Denov	General Services	\$ 575	Mr. Denov was an Electronic Technician at the time of his suggestion. He earned a partial award of \$290 for his suggestion to replace extra radios in Police Supervisors' cars with selectable scan radios. These extra radios were installed in other City vehicles needing radios. Total first year's savings were \$8,670. This is the remainder of his award.
Harry F. Haas	Police	\$ 500	Mr. Haas is a Police Officer. He earned a partial award of \$500 with his suggestion to apply the License Tax to cab drivers leasing cabs. Total first year's additional revenue was \$22,368. This is the remainder of his award.
