- H. To comply with Title VI of the Civil Bi, hits Act of 1964 (PL 88-352) and all requirements imposed by the Federal Dibitter Assistance Administration pursuant to that Title to the end that, in accordance with Title VI of that Act and the Repulsion, no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, religion, nationality, sex, age, or economic status, he excluded from participation in, be denied the Lenetits of, or be otherwise subjected to diverging under any program or activity for which the Applicant received Federal financial assistance from the Agency and HURLBY GIVES ASSURANCE THAT it will inconclustely take any measures necessary to effectuate this agreement.
