

RESOLUTION NO. R-251526Adopted on FEB 11 1980

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Robert M. Nichols	Park and Recreation	\$25	Mr. Nichols is a Field Representative in the Park Division. He suggested that storage areas be traded between functions rather than constructing a new storage area. Savings were \$250 in construction costs.
Evelyn S. Herrmann	Park and Recreation	\$25	Ms. Herrmann is a Community Program Specialist III. She suggested that adjourned Council Meetings be shown on the previous meeting's agenda rather than print a separate notice. Savings are \$228 in printing and distribution costs.
Cynthia E. Hill	Purchasing	\$25	Ms. Hill is a Buyer. She suggested that specifications for traffic controls be updated. Although savings were impossible to calculate, this was considered to be a significant preventive improvement.
Joan E. Knabel	Personnel	\$20	Ms. Knabel was an Intermediate Typist at the time of her suggestion. She suggested that Form CS-490 be revised to improve the ease of processing. Savings were impossible to calculate, but this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Jan E. Johnson	City Clerk	\$20	Ms. Johnson is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested that a rolodex file be created to track files checked out by other City departments. Although savings were impossible to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Herbert M. Yaklin	Park and Recreation	\$20	Mr. Yaklin is a Utility Worker I in the Park Division. He suggested that a back-up alarm be installed on the winch truck. Although savings could not be calculated, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
