Nathan J. Washington	General Services	\$20	Mr. Washington is a Painter in the Buildings Division. He suggested that graffiti be removed from facility walls on an as discovered basis. This has proven to be reasonably effective in some areas of the City. Although savings are impossible to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Charlene K. Granstedt	Police	\$20	Ms. Granstedt is a Dispatch Clerk II. She suggested that the movie describing the Police Communications System be duplicated on a videocassette tape. The tape will be used in recruit training. Although savings were impossible to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Donald E. Prisby	Personnel	\$20	Mr. Prisby is an Associate Personnel Analyst. He suggested that magnetic card letter indices be updated. Although savings were impossible to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Michael D. Eacobellis Earnest D. Warren	General Services	\$20	Mr. Eacobellis and Mr. Warren are Equipment Mechanics in the Equipment Division. They suggested that air filters on 5700 series refuse packers be relocated. This is expected to save \$142 annually in repair costs.
Myrna F. Choate	Risk Management	\$20	Ms. Choate is an Administrative Aide II. She suggested that an Interview Comments form be used by the Personnel Department to give prospective employees a chance to evaluate the interview process. Although savings were impossible to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
