

RESOLUTION NO. R-251653

Adopted on APR 22 1980

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

| Dennis M. Grady German Gonzalez | Personnel | \$ 65 | Mr. Grady and Mr. Gonzalez are Associate Personnel Analysts. One year ago they earned a \$60 partial award for their suggestion to pre-print the back of job announcements. Total first year's savings were \$1,237. This is the remainder of their award. |
| Daniel Mata | Park and Recreation | \$ 65 | Mr. Mata is an Equipment Operator I in the Park Division. He suggested that the pivot bar of mower units be modified to prevent the units from breaking loose from the mowers. This is expected to save \$1,310 annually in repair costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review. |
| Robert M. Nichols | Park and Recreation | \$ 50 | Mr. Nichols is a Crew Leader in the Park Division. He suggested that a second cradle be added to the 3-axle tower truck to prevent vibration damage to the boom. Although savings were impossible to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational and safety improvement. |
| Joann E. Johnson | Library | \$ 50 | Ms. Johnson is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested that newspapers be stored on shelves rather than on poles. This is expected to save \$3,633 annually in maintenance time. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review. |
| Ralph E. Smith | Park and Recreation | \$ 40 | Mr. Smith is a Utility Worker I in the Park Division. He suggested that lever handles on grass sweepers be strengthened to prevent vibration damage. This saves \$398 annually in repair costs. |
