WHEREAS, United States Congressman Bob Wilson has announced plans to retire as Representative of the 41st District of California upon completion of his fourteenth term; and

WHEREAS, Bob Wilson's twenty-eight years in Congress have been distinguished by his deep concern for the needs of his fellow San Diegans as well as the Nation as a whole; and

WHEREAS, Bob Wilson served for many years as Ranking
Republican on the House Armed Services Committee, dedicating
himself to a strong and vigilant military, and also was prime
mover in the establishment of the National Oceanographic and
Atmospheric Administration, whose accomplishments have benefitted
the Nation and the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, major projects attributed to Bob Wilson's energies and legislative expertise include millions of dollars of contracts for local firms for construction of naval vessels; establishment of a Veterans Administration Regional Office in San Diego; the location of supercarrier and nuclear submarine facilities here; the freeing of surplus federal land for development of the UCSD Medical School and VA Hospital; the dredging of San Diego Bay to accommodate supercarriers, with use of the spoil to create Harbor Island; construction of a pioneering water desalinization plant in San Diego; construction of a new main Post Office, Federal Office Building, and Federal Courthouse, and plans for a new Navy Regional Medical Facility; and

is deserving of greatest commendation and sincere gratitude for his effective representation of thousands of San Diegans in Washington in the finest tradition of public service.
