BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council has ascertained the current or prevailing rate of per diem wages paid by private employers in the City for each craft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute the contract, and does hereby declare that the wage scale included in said specifications is the said current or prevailing rate for the various crafts therein mentioned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Purchasing Agent of the City of San Diego be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to publish in accordance with law, notice to contractors calling for bids for the work hereinabove described, in accordance with the plans and specifications hereinabove referred to.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible and reliable bidder for

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution 215298 is hereby rescinded, and the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer \$19,000.00 from CIP 23-390.1(6) Paradise Hills Park and Recreation Center - Sports Field Drainage to CIP 23-397 Paradise Hills Community Park Miscellaneous Improvements, Capital Outlay Fund 30245.
