

RESOLUTION NO. R-251885Adopted on MAY 27 1980

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Robert L. Davis	General Services	\$ 20	Mr. Davis is a Plumber in the Buildings Division. He suggested that a notice be published reminding City employees that suggestion awards are taxable. This was considered to be a significant public relations improvement.
Margaret A. McLaughlin Herb Wilkinson	Treasurer Planning	\$ 20	Ms. McLaughlin is a Typist in the Treasurer's Office, and Mr. Wilkinson is a Planner in Planning. They suggested that a printer be eliminated. This saves the City rental on the equipment.
Louie A. Vega	Fire	\$ 20	Mr. Vega is a Fire Captain. He suggested that the location of the nozzle and fitting compartment be changed to eliminate a safety hazard. This was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Jerome W. Drilling	Fire	\$ 20	Mr. Drilling is a Fire Fighter. He suggested that turnout clothing be better identified. This is expected to reduce confusion and loss of equipment. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
John A. Barton Ascencion Reyes	Property	\$ 20	Mr. Barton is a Greenskeeper Supervisor, and Mr. Reyes is a Gardener at the Stadium. They suggested that automatic sprinkler control valves be permanently located. Although savings were difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
