RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO OF CERTAIN UNINHABITED, UNINCORPORATED
TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, STATE OF
CALIFORNIA, KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS "KAISER-MISSION
GORGE ANNEXATION"

WHEREAS, an application for the annexation of certain
uninhabited territory to The City of San Diego, known and designated
as "KAISER-MISSION GORGE ANNEXATION," has been filed with
the Local Agency Formation Commission pursuant to Government
Code, Section 54791, and

WHEREAS, the executive officer of this Commission has filed a
report relative to said proposed annexation, which report has been
reviewed and considered by the Commission, and said Commission
has found and determined that

1. The hearing on the proposed reorganization, consisting of an-
nexation of said territory to the City of San Diego, and detachment of
said territory from the San Diego County Flood Control District-Zone 2
was held on the date and at the time and place set therefor and due
notice of said hearing was given in the manner required by law.

2. At the hearing the Commission called for, heard and con-
sidered all interested parties and read and considered the report of
the Executive Officer.

3. The description of the boundaries of the Territory is not
definite and certain, but may be made so if modified to conform to Ex-
hibit C attached hereto.

4. The description of the boundaries of the Territory does con-
form to lines of assessment and ownership

5. All owners of land have consented in writing to the proposed
reorganization.

6. The Territory includes 102 acres and is uninhabited.

7. The Commission certifies that it has reviewed and considered
the information contained in the EIR prepared by The City of San
Diego. The Commission finds that mitigation measures to reduce the
significant effects identified in the EIR are the responsibility of The
City of San Diego and not LAFCO, and that such measures can and
should be adopted by The City of San Diego.

8. The Commission hereby approves a proposed reorganization
consisting of annexation of territory, described in Exhibit C and at-
tached hereto, to the City of San Diego; and detachment of territory,
described in Exhibit C and attached hereto, from the San Diego County
Flood Control District-Zone 2, subject to the proposed conditions
as stated in Exhibit D attached hereto and incorporated herein.

9. Pursuant to Government Code, Section 56271.1, The City of San
Diego is hereby authorized to initiate reorganization proceedings in
compliance with Government Code, Section 56430 et seq. and this
resolution.

10. The Executive Office of this Commission is directed to mail
and file certified copies of this resolution in accordance with Govern-
ment Code, Section 56272. NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as
follows:

That the Council of The City of San Diego hereby approves the
annexation to the City of San Diego of that certain territory in the
County of San Diego, State of California, designated as "KAISER-
MISSION GORGE ANNEXATION," and more particularly described as
follows:

All that unincorporated territory in the County of San
Diego, State of California, being portions of Lots "E" and
"F" of the partition of a portion of Lot 70, Rancho Mission of
San Diego, Civil Case No. 15191 in the Superior Court of San
Diego County on file in the Clerk's Office of said County,
bounded and described as follows:

matter. I am the principal clerk of the San Diego Daily Transcript, a
newspaper of general circulation, printed and published daily, except

the Superior Court of the County of San Diego, State of California, under
the date of January 23, 1909, Decree No. 14894; and the



Beginning at the point of intersection of the North line of said Lot "E" with the boundary line of the City of San Diego as established in Ordinance No. 4019 (New Series), a copy of which was filed for record on August 10, 1970, File Page No. 187812 of Official Records:

1. Thence southwesterly and westerly along said City of San Diego boundary to the southwesterly terminus of Course No. 7.U. being designated therein as South 78°15' West 881.00 feet, being an angle point in the boundary line of the land described in deed of Vernon R. Dennis, recorded July 25, 1933 in Book 222, Page 358 of Official Records;

2. Thence along said boundary line South 25°45'38" East 1043.43 feet to an angle point thereon;

3. Thence continuing along said line South 48°09'05" East 1191.82 feet to an angle point therein;

4. Thence southeasterly in a direct line to the westerly terminus of Course No. 4 in the boundary line of the City of San Diego as established by Resolution No. 18080 being on the southeasterly right of way line of County Road Survey No. 1634 map on file in the County Engineer's Office of said County;

5. Thence in a general northeasterly and easterly direction along said southeasterly right of way line to the North line of said Lot "F";

6. Thence westerly along the North line of said Lots "F" and "E" to the point of beginning.
