A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN OPEN SPACE LAND FOR THE SAN DIEGO OPEN SPACE PARK FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1. - MISSION TRAILS REGIONAL PARK.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council, for and on behalf of the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1 - Mission Trails Regional Park, hereby declares its intention to hold a hearing to determine whether or not the District should acquire certain property owned by KAISER CEMENT AND GYPSUM CORPORATION and comprising approximately 386.08 acres located on the north side of Mission Gorge Road which property is more particularly described as portions of Lots B, C, E and F of the subdivision of a portion of Lot 70 of Rancho Mission of San Diego, for open space park purposes.

2. That said parcel is more particularly described on that document on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 252005.

3. That no park improvements to said property are presently proposed.

4. That on July 1, 1980, at the hour of 8:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers, Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 "C" Street, San Diego, California, the City Council will hear any persons interested in the matter of the acquisition of said property and will consider and finally act on the acquisition of said property.



That a copy of this resolution shall be posted on the bulletin board of the City Administration Building and be published in a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City once a week for two weeks, the posting and first publication to be on or before the 10th day prior to the day of hearing.
