

RESOLUTION NO. R-252122Adopted on JUN 24 1980

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Robert L. Davis	General Services	\$440	Mr. Davis is a Plumber in the Buildings Division. He suggested that a flow switch be installed on the water make-up line to the main boiler at the Central Police Station. This is expected to save \$2,958 annually in maintenance and material costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Jim D. Slade Frank Kennally	General Services	\$400	Mr. Slade is a Building Maintenance Supervisor, and Mr. Kennally is a Painter in the Buildings Division. They suggested that a 200 series colorant dispenser be purchased for City paint crews. This is expected to save \$8,039 annually in labor and material costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Walter R. Newbern	Engineering and Development	\$345	Mr. Newbern is an Associate Land Surveyor in the Field Division. He suggested that a detailed manual accounting system be eliminated now that AMRIS recovers those costs. This is expected to save \$2,299 annually in processing costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Eldon D. Smith	Police	\$325	Mr. Smith is a Sergeant in the Traffic Bureau. He suggested that free bus service from the School District be used to transport School Safety Patrol students to summer camp. This saves \$3,263 annually in transportation costs.
Robert L. Davis	General Services	\$320	Mr. Davis is a Plumber in the Buildings Division. He suggested that an outside air temperature control be installed on the 20th and B boiler. This is expected to save \$2,111 annually in fuel and maintenance costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
