WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Richard J. Jinings	General Services	\$175	Mr. Jinings is an Equipment Mechanic in the Equipment Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$175 with his suggestion to attach the ground lead to the bolt which holds the forward clutch disc on hydraulic pump clutches on refuse vehicles. One year's experience has shown a total savings in maintenance costs of \$3,510. This is the remainder of his award.
William V. Nery	General Services	\$165	Mr. Nery is an Equipment Mechanic in the Equipment Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$160 for his suggestion to remove some of the relays from the electrical system of refuse vehicles. One year's experience has shown a total savings of \$3,240 in maintenance costs. This is the remainder of his award.
Thomas A. Wormington	General Services	\$165	Mr. Wormington is an Electrician in the Buildings Division. He suggested that exit sign guards be installed on gymnasium exit lights. This is expected to save the City \$3,285 annually in exit light replacement costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
William C. Pontsler	General Services	\$155	Mr. Pontsler is an Electrician Supervisor in the Buildings Division. He suggested that energy saving ballasts be used in the lighting systems of City buildings. This is expected to save \$1,545 annually in energy costs.
Robert C. Nightingale	Planning	\$130	Mr. Nightingale is a Zoning Representative. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$135 with his suggestion to eliminate one step in the Zone Variance and Conditional Use Permit procedure. One year's experience has shown a total savings of \$2,670 in processing costs. This is the remainder of his award.
