

RESOLUTION NO. R-252125Adopted on JUN 24 1980

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller i. hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Janet L. Styler	Park and Recreation	\$75	Ms. Styler is an Intermediate Stenographer in the Administrative Division. She suggested that typewriters be bolted to desks at the Conference Building. This is expected to save \$1,541 annually in equipment loss. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Herman A. Clark	Financial Management	\$75	Mr. Clark is a Mini-Bus Driver in the Paratransit Administration. He suggested that the rear view mirrors on Mercedes buses be relocated. Although savings could not be determined, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Marion J. Avila	Library	\$75	Ms. Avila is a Librarian II in the Extension Division. She suggested that the Reserve Hold Card, Form LI-98, be eliminated. This is expected to save \$249 a year in printing costs.
Betty J. Mefford	Fire	\$60	Ms. Mefford is a Dispatch Clerk in the Fire Suppression Bureau. She developed a new format for teleprinter run information to Fire Stations. Not only does this save \$312 annually in paper costs, it also improves operational efficiency.
Paul M. Shanklin	General Services	\$50	Paul M. Shanklin was a Storekeeper II in the Equipment Division at the time of his suggestion. He suggested that high and low limits be established and maintained for auto parts. Savings could not be calculated. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
